Khoo Kongsi, Boon San Tong

"The Boon San Tong Khoo Kongsi is the lesser known of the two Khoo clan associations in the inner city of George Town. It was built by a branch of the Leong San Tong Khoo Kongsi, www.asiaexplorers.com/malaysia/khoocongisi_leongsantong.htm. The Boon San Tong is the ancestral temple of the Khoo subclan known as the Hai Kee Kak, or "Sea Edge Pillar". They are the descendents of Khoo Kong Oon, a fifth generation Leong San Tong Khoo. The most illustrious member of this subclan is Khoo Thean Teik, who was instrumental in making Boon San Tong the most powerful component of the association. He was one of the founding members of the Boon San Tong clan temple in 1878."

Penang and Malacca have been inscribed by Unesco as Malaysia's first two cultural World Heritage Sites. Our submission was titled ***Historic Centres of Melaka and Penang***. 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Penang Food of the month—Curry Mee.

Penang Curry Mee is also called Curry Laksa in Singapore except Penang Curry Mee is using Yellow Noodle vs Thick Noodle being used in Singapore. It is made with coconut-based curry soup. The main ingredients for most hawker stalls in Penang Curry Mee include tofu puffs, cuttle fish, shrimp and cockles. Some vendors may use chicken versus instead of shrimp. Cockles are usually very commonly used in Penang Curry Mee and most vendors would add them into Penang Curry Mee unless customers request not to have cockles.

It is one of the MUST try hawker food which only unique in Penang if you like the spicy food, or adventurous to try something different.



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
